The following notes reflect our understanding of the discussions and decisions made at this meeting. If you have any questions, additions or comments, please contact us at the above address. We will consider the notes to be accurate unless written notice is received within 10 working days of the date issued.

The purpose of the meeting was to introduce the SR 76 Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) Study to those in attendance and seek initial input for consideration into the study. Display boards and a brief slideshow presentation were shown to discuss existing project characteristics and issues that will serve as input for the team to develop possible improvement alternatives. Daphne Spanos with FDOT welcomed the attendees and introduced the team members. The slideshow presentation was done by Jeff Novotny from American Consulting Engineers of Florida, LLC who is the consultant selected by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the study. A copy of the presentation **including the script** has been posted to the sr76martin.com project website. The following identifies the key items that were discussed at the meeting:

1. Jeff Novotny stated that the cut-off date to receive comments for this meeting is April 30, 2009, but comments regarding the PD&E Study may be made at anytime. Jeff Novotny also stated that the presentation material will be posted to the sr76martin.com website by April 20, 2009.
2. Ann Perrota from Martin County's Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) asked if the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) wants for the MPO to provide in writing their request for bicycle facilities to be installed within the corridor. Daphne Spanos stated that this was not necessary since the request is already identified in the Multimodal Scoping Form, provided by FDOT's Office of Modal Development.
3. Larry Hymowitz asked if there were any funding for the design and for Right-of-Way (RW) acquisition. Jeff Novotny stated that the project is funded for design, however, there may be a need for RW funding for drainage ponds. The project team will minimize R/W needs since it is rare to have a 2-lane facility (west of SW Locks Road) with 200' of R/W. Also, if the westbound to southbound loop ramp at the interchange of SR 76 and I-95 is removed then that area could be utilized for a pond without the need for purchasing R/W.
4. Larry Hymowitz asked if any coordination was done with Florida's Turnpike regarding widening or improvements along SR 76 and if the project team is aware of any planned SunPass slip ramps. Jeff Novotny stated that coordination with Florida's Turnpike has not

been done yet and the project team is not aware of any planned SunPass slip ramps, however, a meeting will be scheduled in the near future

5. Ann Perrota stated that the next MPO meeting is May 18, 2009 and requested if the project team could make a presentation then. Daphne Spanos will check with the FDOT's liaison on this item. Daphne Spanos stated that if any agencies would like the project team to make a presentation of this study to feel free to send her any requests.
6. Jeff Novotny stated that the drainage design for the study is intended to follow the South Florida Water Management District's (SFWMD's) new Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL) criteria.
